Senate House Bill 2815 Greenhouse Gas Emissions

This bill passed the legislature and calls for miles-traveled reductions of 18 percent by 2020, 30 percent by 2035, and 50 percent by 2050. The legislators decided we drive 10,000 miles per year. This means you will only be allowed to drive 5000 miles per year by 2050! I guess you will just have to buy a couple extra cars to get to work each year. It is up to our local municipalities to determine how best to get us to comply.
