## January 2006 PCMC Tech Session

Chris Johnson organized this tech session to help members understand how to evaluate a classic mustang you may be thinking about buying.

Chris used his place of employment, Burien City Garage, to hold the session. Thanks to Chris and the owner of the garage, Duane Quande for letting the club do this. There were about 20 members at the session that started about 10:00.

We had three cars to evaluate, Robert Vawter's 1967 coupe, Kirk Charboneau's 1965 coupe and David Glidwell's 1966 coupe. Chris started with Robert's 67

and used Kirk's 65 on the hoist to get under it. He described a possible order for doing the evaluation.

1. Check the numbers using door data tag and information on the chassis and components. This will tell you how the car was built, engine, trans, color, options, etc. The car is more valuable if the numbers all match. Chris had several manuals to help analyze the numbers. This information is also available on a web site.
2. Check the car for overall condition. Are all the parts there, How much body damage does it have. How much rust does it have. Is the interior complete? Do the accessories work?
3. Under the car, check the condition of the suspension. Chris showed us how to unload the ball joints to check them. He checked the tie rods and the steering, looking for worn parts.
4. He checked the brakes, including lines and looked for other leaks and problems.
5. He checked the drive train.
6. He looked for body damage and rust you may not see while the car is on the ground.

We then looked at David's 66 coupe, which is a nice restored coupe. Chris looked at the front suspension and other parts. The car looked good.

I had to leave about 12:30. Several of the group went to Bison Creek Pizza for lunch.
