Vice President: Heather Messing is now our new Vice President. She has taken over plans for our annual banquet to be held in Feb.

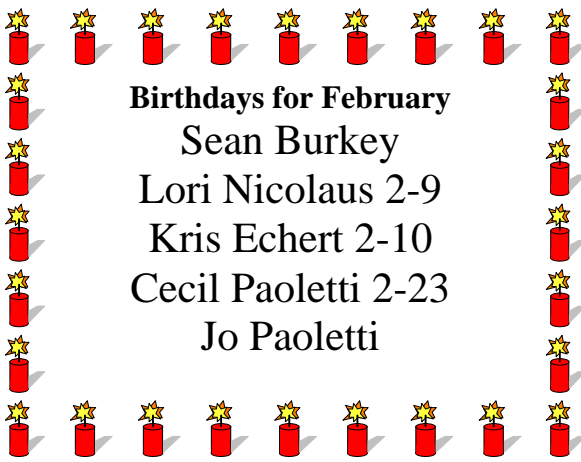
Secretary’s Report: December minutes were approved as written.
