HISTORICS July 4-6 2003*

This year event celebrity is Parnelli Jones, 1963 Indy 500 winner, 1970 Trans-AM winner in a Mustang and five times Baja 500 and three time Baja 1000 winner.

Ford is featured on the 100th Anniversary of Ford Racing, more than 20 highly significant historic Fords will be featured. The Ford Mustangs originally driven by Parnelli Jones and George Follmer will be raced.

Also, 250 vintage racecar's are expected to enter. Ferraris, Lotuses. Cobras, Corvettes, Porsches, Austin Healeys, lots of Mustangs and one fast Falcon driven by Randy Dunphy. Tom Armstrong's one of 563 Corvette Grand Sport. The Edelbrocks will drive Corvettes and Shelby Mustangs. At least one Ford GT 40 will be raced.

Pacific Raceway is a challenging 2 ¼ mile road course with nine turns, 300 foot elevation drop, and ¾ mile straightaway.

An additional 250 vintage and collector cars from local car clubs will be on display in the car corral.

Tours and Events, Margaret Petersen. Margaret reminded the members the Dinner Night Out, May 13, would be at the "Olive Garden" in Federal Way. Since this will be on a Tuesday Chris Johnson was able to get a reservation for 6:30 PM. The Bellevue Pony Trails will be on July 18. Anyone interested in spending the night at the Evergreen Inn in Levenworth, followed by river rafting and perhaps attending the stock car race in Wenatchee should contact Margaret Petersen.
