He bought 2 duffel bags in Alabama, and would like to auction those off, also he mentioned getting \$50 gift certificates from "Thai Bistro Restaurant" and purchasing them for \$40 each and putting the extra \$ into the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary slush fund...he's still trying to figure things out, and would love any ideas. He will announce at our car show if anyone joins the club today, they can join us in the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary drive.

Ed brought up the idea of raising annual dues from \$25 per year to \$30...will have to wait until Jan. 2010 to vote on though.

Also another idea he mentioned was, split the pot/member in attendance winners will donate 10% of their winnings back into the 'slush fund'
