These components came originally with Kris Echert's 69 Mustang. Both worked well when they were removed.

They were replaced with higher HP engine and a built C-4.

302 Engine – \$400. Good compression, doesn't burn oil, Edelbrock 289 Performer intake, Flame-Thrower II coil, chrome valve covers, May have a mild aftermarket cam, has a slightly lumpy idle. Block casting code: E0AE D3C which translates to 1980. Late 70s or later heads with 5/8" (small size) spark plugs. C-4 Transmission - \$150. Ford Mercury made, includes a flex plate.
