Tours & Events: Dave Glidewell reminded us of the tech session to be held this Sat. the 10th.

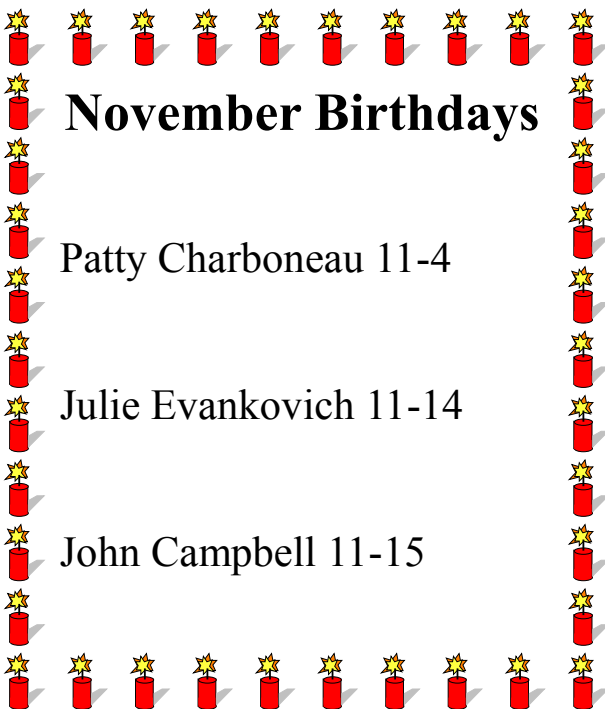

Upholstery Tech Session

It's as easy as ABC, right? NOT! On Saturday October 3, 2009 members of PCMC and Mustangs Northwest met in Kent at ABC Upholstery at 10:00 am with seats, buns and seat covers in hand. Mike, the owner and instructor, welcomed everyone and found his hands full with this group who were all very anxious to get started. Attendees brought seats that were different colors, years and styles. Mike took the process step by step, sharing terms, tips and making sure no one moved ahead until everyone was ready and to that point.

Even those who have done this task before learned something new and appreciated the tips. When replacing parts of the foam, Mike showed the group how to avoid having foam seams show through. Mike told us what tools worked best for what type of jobs. Several times Mike reminded us to use our fists, not fingers, how to fold over and which corners to do first and why.

There was one new seat cover that had card board inserts instead of wire so the card was removed and wire inserted to avoid waves and uneven results later. A training session on preparation prior to welding was provided for those with cracked metal and broken seats.

Mike even showed the men how to sweep off the table so that they wouldn't ruin their new seat covers when they turned them over and slide them along the surface.

Lunch was provided half way through the day. Mike's wife and daughters barbecued foot longs, provided

vegetables, chips and homemade cookies and brownies along with refreshments. What a fun, interesting and helpful tech session. I'm glad I made the 75 mile trip to watch all this activity and see this enthusiastic group. I'm sure the group would like to thank Mike for his patients, knowledge and assistance and also thank his wife for allowing him to schedule this event on their wedding anniversary.
