Secretary's Report: August 2008 minutes were approved as written.

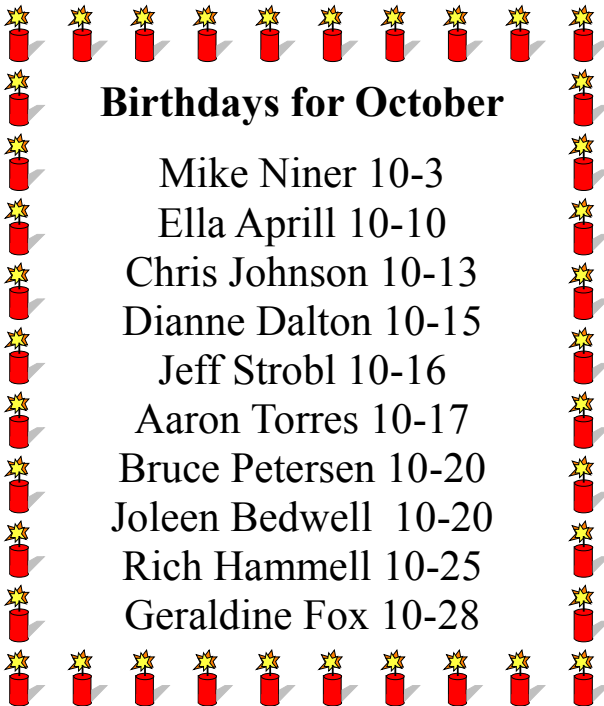
