Friday the 8th Steve from England arrives and will be at the Apogee.

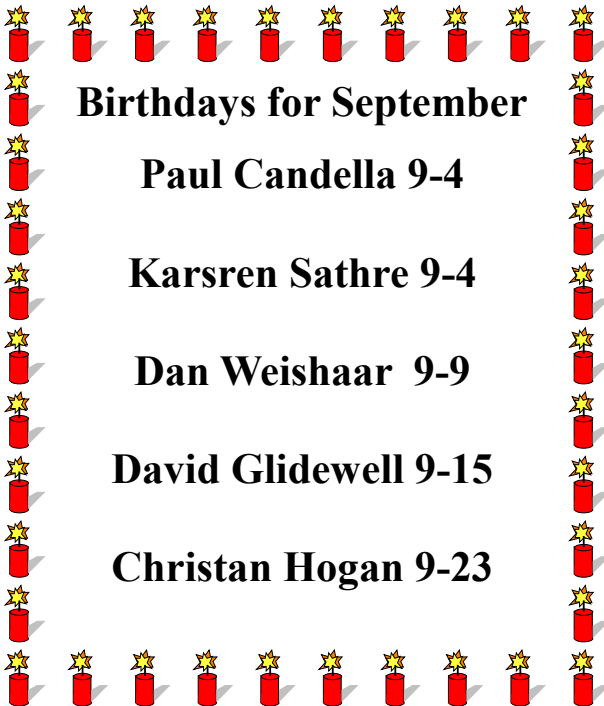
