August 2003 Club Meeting Minutes

President Gary Dagan opened the meeting at 7:30 PM at Bowen Scarff FORD on Friday, August 1. The members socialized, inspected Mustangs and generally amused themselves until the business portion of the meeting was started about half an hour later.

President Dagan read the letter sent to PCMC officers, and others, by Gina Wade concerning the recent "Pony Trail" event. Ms. Wade complained about very poor driving practices by the participants, speeding, passing in unsafe places and a general disregard for safety. Gary also read his reply to Ms. Wade wherein he noted that PCMC was being unjustly pilloried. He noted that only 10 or 12 PCMC members participated in the event and that it was unlikely Ms. Wade observed those members in the activities she faulted. Both Gary Dagan and Gary Hallberg went on to also caution the club members that some had been observed spinning wheels on exiting the B-S parking lot. They noted that the owners of B-S would not welcome this sort of activity since it would reflect negatively on the dealership. They further cautioned the membership not to drive recklessly, to keep in mind that people will point fingers and to please be cautious while driving.

Secretary Report, Cecil Paoletti. The minutes for the July meeting were accepted as published in the PEGASUS.

Treasurer Report, Gary Hallberg. The club is solvent. Money was taken in from the sale of folding

Parking lot layout will start at 6:00 PM on Friday, August 15. The show staff will start arriving at 6:00 AM on Saturday, August 16. The "Goodie bag stuffing" will be at the Aprill's house on Thursday evening, August 14. The show still needs door prizes. They are expecting the restored Bowen Scarff sponsored dragster, "PHANTOM," to put in an appearance, but the Ford GT40 is not available. They still need volunteer help. The show preparations are on schedule. Brett Parcy had several requests;

1. The PCMC members should consider registering as "Host Vehicle" to reduce potential conflicts for prizes.
2. Lori will digitally photograph each club member's car when entering.
