March 2003 Club Meeting Minutes

President Gary Dagan opened the meeting at 7:45 PM. The meeting was held at Bowen Scarff FORD on Friday, March 7.

Secretary Report, Cecil Paoletti. The minutes for the February meeting were revised to reflect the correct year, 2003 rather than 2002, and otherwise accepted as published in the February PEGASUS.

Treasurer Report, Gary Hallberg. The club is solvent. Various accounting data were distributed to the officers to define the club's financial position.

Membership Report, Linda Hallberg. 19 members attended the meeting. Four guests, potential new members, were introduced and asked what they were seeking in a club. The guests mentioned they were seeking camaraderie, technical help, cruising and technical sessions. David Glidewell was voted in as a new member at the last Board meeting. He made the great video now being shown at the club's display in the Seattle Roadster Show. We welcome him to the club and thank him for his efforts. Mark Palomar was made a Life Member at the last Board meeting. 'Gene Riggs has joined the Coast Guard. He will be made an Honorary Member for the duration of his enlistment. Questions arose about distribution of the official club membership list. Tom Rowley stated that he distributed the membership list quarterly, in hard

copy, at the general meetings. A decision was made to not distribute the list electronically.

Pegasus Report, Tom Rowley. The February issue was distributed both electronically and in hard copy, as appropriate. The deadline for the March issue has been moved up to March 20 to accommodate travel plans. Brian Benthin (Web Site), Brad Hoffman (Tech Session), Chris Johnson (Rally d'Italy) will provide Tom with information for inclusion in the April Pegasus.

Tours and Events, Margaret Petersen. Margaret was unavailable, but G. Dagan reminded the members the Dinner Night Out, March 13, would be at the Giant's Causeway Irish Pub in Renton. Try to arrive by 6:30 to 7:00 PM. The April Dinner Night Out will be at the XXX Drive In restaurant in Issaquah. Since this is a Sunday we will arrive earlier than usual, about 2:00 to 3:00 PM.

Web Site, Dennis Wagner. Brian Benthin stated that changes have been incorporated into the web site to improve navigation within the site. There have been 19 visitors to the site to date and traffic is building. More car pictures have been added to the site, send yours in now. A car of the month will be selected. To be eligible a data sheet describing the car needs to be available, so send yours in. A method of selecting the car of the month needs to be determined; your ideas are appreciated.

Old Business.

Club member Steve Evankovich's car was used as the centerfold for the April issue of '**Mustangs and Fords**'. Nelia Duarte has prepared flyers for the Seattle Roadster Show that informs the readers about our club, who we are, where and when we meet, and what our activities consist of.

Linda Hallberg reported on business cards for the club members. In quantities of 1000 Kinko's would cost \$145, Staples, \$200, while Linda could produce

New Business.

Gary Hallberg noted the driver's school is underway at Pacific Raceways. Anyone interested in being a "Corner worker" should get in touch with him. He also noted that a toy show is coming up soon at the Kent Commons, and an Old Toy Swap Meet is coming up soon in Puyallup at the fair grounds. Neilia Duarte will soon be posting Roadster Show photos on the web site. Neilia reported that so far 6 members have signed up for the Club Challenge drag racing this summer. She noted that PCMC was the first to bring in a 2003 sponsor for the activity.

'**Blood Enterprises,**' a custom engine shop, will be supporting the activity as a sponsor.

Brett Paracy noted that another tire barrier building session is planned for March 22 at Pacific Raceway. Turns 1, 5 and 7 must be protected by tire barriers if Pacific Raceway is to host a planned NASCAR event. Volunteers are needed to help build the barriers. Volunteers will receive food and drink, and will be permitted to participate in a "Track Day" late in the summer, date to be determined. The benefits are worthwhile. The work isn't difficult. Contact Brett if you are available to help.

Chris Johnson provided further details on his planned "Rally d'Italy." The activity will take place in the general vicinity of Green River Community College, will be 20 to 30 miles in length and require about 2 hours to complete. At this time only one check point, midway on the route, is planned. A spaghetti dinner will be held at the end of the rally. Considerable emphasis was placed on all drivers operating their vehicle strictly in accordance with local traffic laws

and with the utmost safety awareness. A suggestion was made to place participant's driver license in a sealed envelope, along with the emergency route instructions, and to automatically disqualify any participant with an opened envelope.

Insurance continues to be a concern for club members participating in motoring activities. Tom Rowley noted that his auto insurance is null and void if the car is participating in a competitive event. This raises questions for those participating in both drag racing and rallies.
