**Pegasus Report, Tom Rowley.** The April issue was distributed both electronically and in hard copy, as appropriate. The deadline for the May issue is April 24<sup>th</sup>.

**Tours and Events, Margaret Petersen.** Margaret reminded the members the Dinner Night Out, April 13, would be at the "XXX Drive In" in Issaquah. Since this is a Sunday we will arrive earlier than usual, about 2:00 to 3:00 PM. Those interested in a group cruise to the activity should meet at Bowen Scarff Ford at 1:00 PM.

Margaret reminded us the "Tulip Festival" was occurring. The Bellevue Pony Trails were mentioned to assess interest, as was the Monroe Car Swap Meet, May 17 – 18. "N W Auto Mall" will be at the swap meet photographing cars. Perhaps we could consider going as a club for the autumn meet.

There is a group river rafting trip available, contact Margaret for details.

**Web Site, Dennis Wagner.** The server we had been using developed problems and purged a portion of the web site. We are now switching to a new server facility courtesy of an anonymous donor who paid for a year's use of the new server. Each member will be receiving an e-mail with their account name and a generic pass word. After logging on the member should install their own personal password. Non-members will be able to visit and view the web site, but only PCMC members will be able to post to the site.

**Technical Committee, Brad Hoffman.** The wiring work on the Lievero Mustang is still planned, but a date hasn't been set yet.

The "Export Brace" installation for Tom Rowley's Mustang is still under consideration, but no definite plans have been made.

Gary Dagan asked the Eckerts if they were ready to host a tech session on their Mustang. They aren't quite ready for that yet.

**Seattle Roadster Show.** Will Gearing attended our meeting and brought our check for providing security services at this year's show. Over 44,000 people visited this year's show. The show had 310 cars participating and 150 import cars participated. The management of the show is planning to contract the security for the show to a local organization. The contract will be a flat fee, but the fee will be negotiable. The plan is to need security for 12, 10 and 10 hours and will require at least 6 people per shift. The contractor club can select the hours each participant would work. It was suggested the participants come early, tour the show and then start their shift. The offer will be presented to the clubs soon. Tickets for next years show will be \$12. The show will require a theme and different cars than were displayed at this year's event. There will be a revised judging system in place for next year's show. Brett Paracy will be the PCMC contact for the next show. There will be a PCMC committee to plan our participation in the next show. Brett suggested we bid on providing the security service. This year we won second place, received a trophy and \$200, and earned \$300 providing security. He recommended we continue with a 5-car display due to space restrictions. You request space in advance, but you may not get as much as you want. Brett suggested that first place always seems to go to cars that are absolutely unmodified. There is a Class Award for participation. He suggested a Hawaiian theme for next year.
